WHEREAS; the Town Council of the Borough of West View desires to obtain funds from the Department of Economic Development in the amount of \$10,000 (Ten Thousand Dollars) under the Federal Housing and Community Development Act as amended; and

WHEREAS; the Town Council of the Borough of West View has determined the need demolish the property at 18 Glenmore Avenue, as it is hazardous to the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Borough of West View and the general public;

SECTION ONE - The Town Council of the Borough of West View does hereby formally request a \$10,000 Grant from the Department of Economic Development.

SECTION TWO - The Town Council of the Borough of West View designates North Hills Council of Governments Executive Director Wayne E. Roller as the official to file all applications, documents and forms between the Borough of West View and the Allegheny County Department of Economic Development.

Be it further **RESOLVED**, that the Borough of West View will assure, where applicable, the provision of the full local share of the project costs.

Be it further **RESOLVED**, that the Borough of West View will assure, that the project will be awarded or under construction within 180 days after contractual execution.


